

Faculty Position

International Business

(Open Rank)

The College of Business and Economic Development at The University of Southern Mississippi anticipates an opening for a tenure-track position in International Business. Faculty level is contingent on qualifications. Starting date for the position is August 2004. The primary responsibilities for the position are teaching undergraduate courses in International Business and international courses in another business discipline.

Secondary fields are flexible. The teaching load is six to nine hours per semester depending on qualifications. Candidates would be responsible for an International Business major with 50 to 75 students. Representatives of the college will conduct informational interviews at the AIB meetings in Stockholm, Sweden. Minimum qualifications: a Ph.D. (ABD accepted) in International Business or a related business specialization; evidence of excellence in teaching international business or related subjects; and demonstrated potential to publish in respectable academic or practitioner journals. Salary and benefits are competitive and dependent upon qualifications.

Qualified applicants are invited to send a vita, three references, summary of courses taught and teacher evaluations, and samples of published or ongoing research. Complete application packages must be received no later than August 1, 2004, to ensure full consideration; however applications will be accepted until the position is filled.
