Assistant Professor of International Business

Oakland University has a vacancy for a tenure-track Assistant Professor in International Business beginning in August 2006, subject to position approval. Applicants should have a Ph.D. with a major in international business or another functional area of business with a strong international business focus. Candidates should demonstrate a strong commitment to teaching preferably with some teaching experience and a clear research agenda in international business and/or international aspects of a business functional area. Successful candidates should be able to contribute to the school's undergraduate and graduate business programs and to expanding the international business component of the curriculum.

Oakland University is a state-supported institution located in Rochester, Michigan, approximately 25 miles north of Detroit among the rolling hills and woodlands of Meadowbrook, the former Dodge-Wilson estate donated to the State of Michigan in 1957.
