Faculty Position in International Business San Francisco State University College of Business Announcing An Open Position for Fall 2006

POSITION: One full-time tenure-track position in International Business for Fall 2006. The position requires graduate and undergraduate teaching, professional development and academic research, student advising, and service to the college and department. Candidates are sought who have expertise in International Business in a geographical area in the Pacific Rim, Europe or Latin America. Candidates should be able to teach an introductory course in International Business but should also have a functional area specialty such as Global Strategic Management.

RANK AND SALARY: Appointment to these positions will be at the rank of assistant professor. Salaries are dependent on qualifications and within the ranges typically available in the California State University System.

APPLICATION PROCESSING DATE: January 30, 2006.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Earned Ph.D. in Business (closely related fields will also be considered);
- Academically qualified and/or professionally qualified by current AACSB standards;
- A clearly demonstrated primary focus in teaching and research in international business;
- Evidence of excellence in teaching (such as "superior" teaching evaluations and awards).

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

- A track record of published research in international business;
- Evidence of excellence in working with students from highly diverse backgrounds.

THE INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS DEPARTMENT: The department is one of the largest and oldest International Business programs in the country with nearly 450 undergraduate students in the concentration. There are also students concentrating in International Business in the graduate programs. Both the faculty and students are highly diverse groups of people, reflecting the special nature of the San Francisco Bay Area and the Pacific Rim.

THE COLLEGE: The College of Business is accredited by the AACSB at both the graduate and undergraduate levels. The college offers graduate and undergraduate degrees and serves approximately 1,000 graduate and 5,000 undergraduate students. Courses are offered both day and evening. There are approximately 100 full-time tenure-track faculty members. **THE UNIVERSITY:** San Francisco State University, a member of the California State University system, serves a diverse student body of almost 27,000 undergraduate and graduate students from the U.S. and almost 110 countries around the world. The mission of the University is to promote scholarship, freedom, human diversity, excellence in instruction, and intellectual accomplishment. SFSU faculty members are expected to be effective teachers and demonstrate professional achievement and growth through continued research, publications, and/or creative activities. Part of the College of Business mission is to ensure that the international content of the programs and courses reflects the increasingly global scope of San Francisco Bay Area organizations.
