Umeå University

Umeå University, <www.umu.se> with its beautiful campus setting, is a comprehensive state university. The university is forty years old but recognized as one of the major institutions for research and higher education in Sweden. A total of 25,000 students are enrolled in one hundred and ten educational programs and courses in five faculties and campus schools. Students come from other countries as well as from Sweden. The university is the biggest provider of distance education in the Nordic countries – more than 5,000 students are enrolled in off-campus educational programs in more than fifty different cities. On campus, 3,600 staff members in sixty departments carry out university research within five Faculties: Art, Medicine and Odontology, Social Sciences, Science and Technology, and Teacher Education. The university campus also accommodates seven separate schools: School of Business and Economics, School of Industrial Design, School of Fine Arts, Institute of Technology, School of Environmental Studies, Umeå School of Sports Pedagogies, and School of Restaurant and Culinary Arts.

Umeå School of Business and Economics

Umeå School of Business and Economics <www.usbe.umu.se> (USB E) is one of five such business schools in Sweden. The school offers five educational programs and a large number of courses with a total enrollment of 2,000 students. The school offers bachelor, masters and doctoral degrees. Research within the five departments is well developed in areas of business administration, economics, economic history, law, and statistics. The doctoral programs enroll about one hundred students and the total number of faculty is about two hundred. The school has an extensive international network and is experienced in working closely with private and public organizations in both research and teaching. Every year sixty-six university partners from all over the world send students to Umeå. Approximately forty five percent of the business school's graduates have spent one to two semesters abroad at one of our partner universities. USB E also offers five one-year full time Master's programs in English: Accounting and Finance; Entrepreneurship and Dynamic Business Contexts; Marketing Research and Analysis Management; Management: People, Projects, and Processes; and Economics. The degree awarded at the completion of the program is an *Ekonomie Magister* (Master of Science in Business or Economics).
