Responsibilities

The College of Business Administration at Northeastern University invites applications for an **Assistant Professor** position in **International Business**, effective **September 2007**. A concurrent capability to teach and research in **Strategy** or **Entrepreneurship** is required. Undergraduate teaching will be in the college's nationally ranked Bachelor of Science in International Business program as well as in the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration program. Graduate teaching will be in the full-time and part-time MBA, programs. Salary is competitive and negotiable, depending on doctoral status, rank and experience. Support for research is available.

Qualifications

Candidates must possess the doctoral degree and have a strong commitment to excellence in teaching and scholarly research and to working with a diverse student population. Ph.D. candidates close to dissertation defense are welcome to apply.

Additional Information

Research Opportunities: Faculty members are expected to be actively engaged in research and publishing activities. Support is available in the form of summer funding, release time from teaching, graduate research assistants, and travel stipends for presentations at academic conferences. Research fellowships for tenure-track assistant professors are available on a competitive basis.
