The Department of Management is seeking interested individuals to fill visiting positions in the areas of human resource management, strategic management, international management, and China business and management. The visiting positions are from 4 months (Fall or Spring term) to 10 months (both terms, and summer school), commencing August 2007.

The Department of Management focuses on both management education and research, with special relevance to this region and a global perspective. The Department has a team of high quality members with international experiences. The team, collectively and individually, engages in mainstream and China-related research projects. The Department of Management is also a major player in establishing and leading the Asia Academy of Management, an organization of academics devoted to the fostering of management education and research in this region. The research productivity of the department has been ranked consistently at the top in international management research.

Applicants should have (i) a PhD degree, preferably in management, business, or other relevant discipline; (ii) strong teaching performance; and (iii) relevant professional and industry experience. Duties include: (a) teaching undergraduate and MBA courses in one or two of the following areas: human resource management, strategic management, international management, and China business related topics; and (b) assisting department in student related activities and advising students with concentrations in the department.

Applications should be accompanied by a detailed CV showing teaching, professional, and industry experiences, and sample research papers and teaching portfolio. Appointments will initially be made on a fixed-term contract basis, renewable subject to mutual agreement. Applications will be accepted until the positions are filled.
