

FACULTY POSITION IN INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS / STRATEGY

DESCRIPTION: Tenure-track position in the Department of Management at the assistant professor level. The position calls for a motivated individual with excellent teaching ability and a record of scholarship commensurate with the length of the period since completing the Ph.D. The successful candidate should possess a strong background in international business and strategy sufficient to teach international business courses as well as our capstone undergraduate strategy course. Experience working with a diverse student body and staff is a desired attribute. 3 quarters, 2 + 2 + 2 teaching load. Starting date: September 16, 2008. Salary: \$80k+.

REQUIRED: Ph.D., DBA, or ABD in final dissertation stage, and relevant teaching experience. Applicants must provide evidence of effective teaching and high promise of scholarship in international business/strategy.
