The Management and International Business Department at Florida International University's College of Business Administration invites applicants for the position of Professor of Leadership. The position will involve substantial visibility within the University and business community and the individual filling the position will also serve as the Director of Academic Research for FIU's Center for Leadership. This is a twelve month position with research release from teaching during the Summer terms. As Director of Academic Research, responsibilities include initiating new research projects, cultivating research relationships with other institutions and our corporate partners, guiding multiple doctoral students and post docs in leadership research, promoting University-wide research opportunities and advancing the academic reputation of the Center for Leadership.

Qualified applicants will have a doctorate degree in Business Administration or a related field with the ability to teach undergraduate, masters, doctoral and executive education courses. The person selected will have the ability to form positive relationships in the academic and business communities. Applicants invited to visit will have a strong record of publishing leadership research in premier journals. Applicants will be considered at the Associate Professor level if research is sufficient for a tenured position at in the College of Business at FIU.
