Tenure-track Faculty Positions in International Business

Korea University Business School (KUBS) (<http://biz2.korea.ac.kr>) is seeking qualified applicants for tenure-track faculty positions in various fields of international business, including, but not limited to, International Strategy, International Finance, International Marketing, or Cross-Cultural Management. The primary responsibility of tenure-track faculty is to conduct high-quality research and teach international business courses in the undergraduate, MBA, and/or Ph.D. programs. The appointment starts either on September 1, 2009 or on March 1, 2010. Depending on experience and qualifications, candidates can be considered for all ranks (Assistant/Associate/Full Professor).

JOB QUALIFICATION:

An earned Ph.D. in International Business or a related field with strong commitment to excellence in research and teaching is required. ABDs can be considered, provided that the degree will be earned by the appointment date.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

The teaching responsibility is six credit hours (two courses) each semester. The courses in our program include all areas in international business. The development and teaching of courses specialized in Asian emerging markets is encouraged. All courses are to be taught in English.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY:

Korea University is located in the vibrant city of Seoul, the capital of South Korea. KUBS, accredited by both AACSB and EQUIS, is the oldest and largest business school in Korea currently with about 85 full-time faculty members, and is expected to grow further. Recently, it has been repeatedly ranked as the country's No. 1 business school. KUBS has approximately 2,500 undergraduate students, 650 students in MBA, 200 students in MS program, and 70 Ph.D. students in various majors such as Accounting, Finance, International Business, Marketing, Management, MIS, and Logistics Services and Operation Management.

ABOUT THE INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS AREA:

The International Business Area has currently 12 full-time faculty members (by far the biggest in Korea) and is planning to actively increase its size. The current faculty members represent various fields in international business, such as international strategy, international marketing, international finance, international HRM, and cross-cultural management.

SALARY AND RESEARCH SUPPORT:

Competitive salary level depending on qualifications and experience. Support for housing and education expenses is available for foreign faculty.
