

Assistant professor International Management / International Business (tenure track)

Department of International Business & Management, University of Groningen, The Netherlands

We welcome applications in the areas of international management (IM) and international business (IB).

The successful candidate will contribute to the development and delivery of IM and IB courses across the BA, MSc and Research Master program in International Business and Management. Following a period of growth and continuing success, the department wishes to further strengthen its position in IB&M research. Members of the department have published in a wide range of journals the last years, including JIBS, Org. Studies, AMJ, IBR, and JWB amongst others and the successful candidate is expected to contribute to this research focus. To facilitate research, the department offers relatively favorable teaching loads. Moreover, the successful candidate will be asked to contribute and develop courses close to his or her field of research.

Requirements:

- Doctoral thesis approved, and possibly some (forthcoming) publications in the field of IB&M in international peer reviewed journals.
- As the IB&M program is in English and attracts a substantial number of non-Dutch students, the successful candidate is expected to be fluent in English.
- Excellent teaching skills

Starting date: not specified; preferably January 2010, possibly sooner.

Salary range: The University of Groningen (founded 1614) offers a salary according to the Dutch university standards, depending on qualifications and work experience and ranges between € 3195 and € 4970 gross per month for assistant professors for a full time position. In addition there are a 8% holiday allowance and a 8.3% end of year bonus. Foreigners can apply for tax-free allowance equal to 30% of their taxable salary. Depending on qualifications, the position is initially offered for a five year period (which can be split in a 3+2 or 2+3 period).
